The Opportunity

The Town of Torbay is seeking expressions of interest from qualified and community-minded individuals to serve as its **Community Representative** on the Board of Directors for the Jack Byrne Regional Sport & Entertainment Centre (JBRSEC).

About the Jack Byrne Regional Sport & Entertainment Centre (JBRSEC).

The Jack Byrne Regional Sport & Entertainment Centre is a key recreational and event facility serving the northeast Avalon region. JBRSEC is owned collaboratively by four surrounding communities: the Town of Torbay, the Town of Logy Bay–Middle Cove–Outer Cove, the Town of Flatrock, and the Town of Pouch Cove. The facility is governed by a ten (10) member appointed Board of Directors.

The facility officially opened in October 2008, thanks in part to the contributions of the late Jack Byrne, for whom the Centre is proudly named.

JBRSEC serves as the home of several local organizations, including the Northeast Minor Hockey Association, the Northeast Junior Eagles, the Outer Cove Marines, and hosts the Prince of Wales Skating Club.

In addition to sport programming, the facility welcomes hundreds of patrons who participate in a variety of recreation programs such as general skating, adult skating, parent and tot skating, and the JBR Wellness Club.

The Centre is also a vibrant hub for community events, attracting thousands of visitors annually for tradeshow, craft fairs, graduations, and the popular Killick Coast Concert Series.

Role and Responsibilities

The Town of Torbay representative will:

- Attend and actively participate in Board meetings and committee work
- Provide oversight and strategic input
- Act in the best interests of the facility and its partner communities
- Serve as a liaison between the Board and the Town of Torbay

Qualifications and Experience

Ideal candidates will demonstrate:

- Strong interest in community recreation and regional collaboration
- Experience in leadership, financial oversight, policy development or strategic planning would be considered an asset.
- Previous board participation would also be considered an asset but is not a prerequisite.
- Ability to work collaboratively and make informed decisions
