

#### MANDATE

The Municipality of Torbay is undergoing a Municipal Plan and Development Regulations Review. These documents guide the development and growth of your community, and we need your input to make sure they reflect our shared vision and goals.



#### The project's main objectives are to create:

• A Municipal Plan with a long-term vision for the Town of Torbay, which takes into account current trends and the changing nature of development and draws from best practices in urban and community planning.

• A Development Regulation
(Bylaw) helps achieve the vision in
the Municipal Plan and that
includes user-friendly and visually
expressed regulations that address
land use issues.







#### **Urban and Rural Planning Act**

The Urban and Rural Planning Act contains the overall framework, authority, powers and processes according to which a municipality provides land use planning services.

Under the Act, and before a municipality takes on responsibility for land use planning, it develops a Municipal Plan and accompanying Development Regulations that must be approved by the provincial government.

Both the Municipal Plan and the Development Regulations must be reviewed on a 5-year basis

#### WHAT IS A MUNICIPAL PLAN?

A Municipal Plan is a document that outlines a municipality's policies on how land in the community should be used. It is prepared with input from the community and is intended to ensure that future planning and development will meet the specific needs of the community.

# WHAT ARE DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS?

Development regulations are a set of rules that work in conjunction with the Municipal Plan. They provide specific details on how land can be used within the municipality.






#### Population Change








#### Housing Unit Growth






# LAND USE ZONING MAP (SIMPLIFIED)




