- Sidewalk Installation on Torbay Rd. \$1,000,000 (capital)
- Road Improvement Gas Tax Agreement \$1,169,470



# **RESIDENT PRIORITY 2**

Water & Wastewater Infrastructure

**BUDGET: \$525,738** 

### **MAJOR PROJECTS**

- Leak Detection \$25,000
- Water Supply Study \$40,758
- Wastewater Sampling \$30,000
- Zone Meter Installation \$1,600,000 (capital)

### **RATES**

- Residential Property Tax 6.7 mils
- Commercial Property Tax 10.5 mils
- 20% Low Income Property Tax Reduction
- 25% Guaranteed Income Property Tax Reduction
- 12 Month Payment Plan Deadline: March 31, 2020



### **RESIDENT PRIORITY 3**

Community Facilities & Parks

**BUDGET: \$1,118,376**

- Northeast Avalon RNC Patrol Expansion \$15,000
- Sidewalk Installation (see Road Infrastructure)

**BUDGET: \$807,465** 

### **MAJOR PROJECTS**

- Expanded Programming (60+ programs) with focus on sports, wellness, youth, & seniors – \$382,100
